Non-Profit Organization Tabling at the Portland Farmers' Market

Eligible non-profit organizations may request to have an informational table at the Portland Farmers' Market during the outdoor market season in Deering Oaks Park. Prior permission and scheduling is done through the Portland Farmers' Market Association (PFMA).

Eligible organizations:

- 1. Federally recognized non-profit.
- 2. Serves Cumberland County and their purpose must be agricultural and/or food related.
- 3. Request submitted and approved by PFMA.

Additional Tabling Guidelines:

- Informational tabling only. Per PFMA Rules, non-farm vendors can only sell items if the proceeds exclusively support Deering Oaks Park.
- Scheduled tabling days are subject to a maximum of 4 times per calendar year, per organization.
- Location of table setup to be determined by PFMA.
- Once approved and scheduled, and upon arrival, please check in at the Market Information Booth.
- Table setup: no larger than a 10'x10' area. If a tent is used, it must be fastened to tent weights.
- Walk-in access only. Vehicles are not allowed to be driven or parked near the tabling site.
- All trash generated by the organization must be cleaned up.
- Any violation of the above guidelines will result in the organization forfeiting any future tabling days.
- When possible (not a requirement), organizations are encouraged to make a donation, in any amount, to PFMA's Food Access Program.
